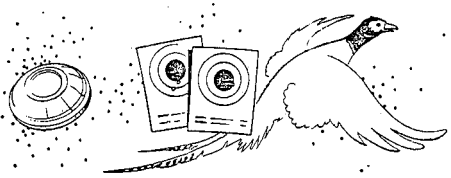

1. **Clubhouse Cleaning Coordinator** – coordinate monthly team leaders, provide procedures, plan around special events. Reports to board of directors (BOD).
2. **Clubhouse Cleaning monthly** (need 12) team leaders – each serves 1 month, executes cleaning tasks according to ~1 hour procedure 3 or 4 times/month, reports to cleaning committee chair.
3. **Clubhouse Cleaning assistants** (need 12) – each serves 1 month, executes cleaning tasks according to ~1 hour procedure 3 or 4 times, works with cleaning team leader.
4. **Rifle range Monitor Coordinator** – serves 1 yr., schedule range monitoring, contact & remind range monitors. Verify & report member service for their “active” credit, reports to Range Manager.
5. **Rifle Range monitors** – (need lots!, 1 for each Saturday & Sunday especially May thru November). Spend time at the range after 9AM, plan to do some shooting yourself, keep an eye on range users, check for their current membership and adherence to posted safety procedures. Clean and straighten up range. During non-use or inclement weather read a book in the clubhouse.
6. **Rifle/pistol Range Manager** – (need 1) recommend and coordinate range equipment modifications and associated rules and policies, maintain and update range signage, including range flags & lockbox function. Reports to BOD.
7. **Orientation Chairman** – (need 1) handles new member orientations, prepares written “how to & who does” handouts. Contacts incoming members, gives orientation at club, Reports to board of directors.
8. **Orientation assistant** - (need 2) assists above Orientation chair
9. **Trap Field Trainer** – (need 2) provides classroom and hands-on training to any members wishing to gain access to use trap house equipment. Reports to Orientation Chairman.
10. **Clubhouse Rental Coordinator** – (need 1) Contact point for rentals, explains policies to user, holds cleaning deposit \$, verifies conditions and inventories, previews and communicates rental dates with other work teams to avoid schedule conflicts. Must have and use online computer. Reports to Treasurer.
11. **Kitchen organizer** – (need 1) Keep kitchen appliances and cupboards, pot, pans, utensils clean and organized. Reports to Clubhouse Cleaning Chair.
12. **Supplies Clerk** - (need 1) Maintain stock of tissue, towels, soaps, and other expendables. Reports to Treasurer.
13. **Work day planner** – (need 1) Organize jobs, requisite materials (power washer, chainsaw, etc.) and contact specialty resources (plumbers, painters, electricians, etc.) for the date. Verify & report member service for their “active” credit. Reports to board of directors.
14. **Work day worker** – (need 10) general labor. Reports to work day planner.
15. **Communication Committee** – (need 3 plus 1 chairman) using membership call lists, job lists, contacts members using phone tree/e-mail/USPS as needed. Must use computer. Chair reports to Secretary
16. **League Trap Shoot Manager** – calls and coordinates personnel resources ahead of scheduled shoot. Manages the help during shoot. Provides written summary of shoot expenses & proceeds. Verify & report member service for their “active” credit, reports to President and Treasurer.
17. **League Trap Shoot Scorer** – (need ~3 per shoot) take trap squad to field and score during the event. Training will be provided to the novice during trap practice beginning in April. Reports to Shoot Manager
18. **League Trap Shoot Helper** – (need ~2 per 6 hour shoot) load trap machines, pick up spent shell casings, clean up after shoot. Reports to Shoot Manager
19. **League Trap Shoot Clerk** – at Lima shoot sign-in arriving shooters, collect fees and score sheets.
20. **League Trap Shoot Cook** – (need several) run kitchen at league shoots at Lima. Grill hots, hamburgs, serve chili or whatever you think will sell! Reports to Shoot Manager
21. **Trap Target delivery** – help with transportation and/or unloading of trap targets when purchased from Beicher’s in E. Rochester. Access to ¾ ton truck or large trailer is needed. Reports to President.
22. **Lawn trimmer** – (need 2, june + aug, july + sept.) do grass trimming (weed whack) around club grounds.
23. **Building Upkeep Committee** – coordinate clubhouse repairs and preventative maintenance tasks
24. **Club Development Committee** – analyze and prepare reports on options for club expansion or large scale upgrade
25. **Professional Training Instructor** - assist or provide NYS DEC Hunter Education Courses (Gun, Bow, Trapping, or Waterfowl ID), NRA Training courses (rifle, shotgun, blackpowder, or pistol)
26. **Secretary Assistant** – Attend meetings, contact members as required, provide computer database, spreadsheet and e-mail support.
